THE ROSS RIFLE AND LEE-ENFIELD

OTTAWA, June 1.—Notwithstanding the secrecy maintained, advices from Australia concerning the importation of a number of the new short 7.5-calibre rifles supplied by the British War Office, have startled British military small arm experts and forced many to admit that the Ross Rifle that is being manufactured for the Canadian Militia at Quebec is a superior small arm. The war office recognizes that Britain was far behind other powers in the prime essential of a military cartridge for flatness of trajectory, which means velocity and more force behind the bullet, increased the "303" cartridge to obtain better results a number of only 40 feet a second, from 1000 to 2000, and the consequence from tests is that the Lee-Enfield rifles in Australia are bursting to an alarming extent.

The designers of the Ross Rifle adopted another policy. Realizing that the British service cartridge was not as powerful as that used by other powers and that sooner or later Canada would be compelled to adopt a higher powered cartridge, care was taken to provide ample strength in case of any possible increase of pressure. PASTOR FLAYS STANDARD HEAD

CHICAGO, Ill., June 1.—John D. Rockefeller and the Standard Oil Company were mercilessly attacked on Sunday by the Rev. A. A. Ross, in a sermon at Ryland Memorial Universalist church. Turning his attention to Standard Oil and its head he said:

"Of these trusts there is one which, for years, under one name or another, has wound its slimy coils about the business interests of the country, destroying competition by means that would put Lucifer to shame for hellish ingenuity, and compelling the great transportation companies to do its dirty work, all the while debauching the manhood of the nation and defying the laws of its country."

"Upon the pages of American History are the names of many whose souls will long be held before the young as worthy of emulation, and whose memory will be a grateful heritage to future years, but the name of the head of this iniquitous trust will never be mentioned by coming generations without a feeling of nausea, that he has given millions to education and religion cannot secure for him respectability in the present nor put a halo around his memory in the future."

ISLAND DISAPPEARS AFTER A SHOCK

ROME, June 1.—One of the results of the volcanic disturbance which has been going on in Southern Italy is the threatened disappearance of the Island of Ustica, situated about 67 kilometers from Palermo, Sicily. Ustica, not only of volcanic formation, but is believed to be the summit of a submarine volcano, the crater of which is far down in the depths of the Mediterranean.

The island is nine square kilometers in area and supports a rural and piscatorial population of about 4,000, 91 per cent of whom are resident prisoners. That is, they are Italian criminals who are sequestered on the island, where they may do as they please, under certain restrictions, so long as they do not change their residence.

OCEAN COATED WITH PUMICE COVERING

HONOLULU, June 1.—(Special)—The schooner Lavinia arrived yesterday from Laysan Island and reported that the ocean in that vicinity is covered for many miles with a heavy coating of pumice. At Laysan Island and on the French Frigate Shoals there were piles of pumice prior to the San Francisco earthquake. It is believed that there were some subterranean outbreaks, probably in connection with the Formosa earthquake. Capt. Schlemmer of the Lavinia says that the overseer at Laysan asserted that the shock of April 18th was felt on the island.

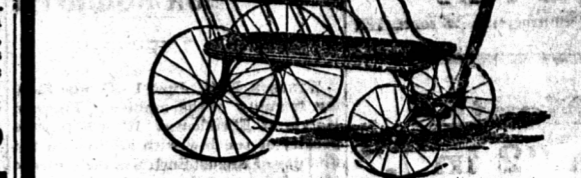
