NEW YORK, May 16—(AP)—Despite continued apprehension over the war and labor rifts, the stock market today managed to negotiate a mild revival that permitted leaders to emerge with fractional advances.

Canadian issues were generally fractions lower. Dome, International Nickel and Brazilian Traction all lost 1-8 while Imperial Oil gained 1-8.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks edged forward 1/8 of a point at 39.5 after Thursday's relapse of 5. Transfers of 287,000 shares, compared with 395,990 the day before and the lowest for a five-hour session since March 5.

General Motors was up 3-8 at 37 3-8 in the wake of settlement of this company's labor dispute which involved wage boosts aggregating \$50,000,000 annually. Chrysler was up 1-2.

Among gainers were U.S. Steel, Bethlehem, Santa Fe, Union Pacific, Kennecott, Anaconda, Pfd. Pont. Union Carbide, Texas Corp., Phillips Petroleum, Shell Union Oil, Goodyear and United Aircraft.
