NOVA SCOTIA PROVINCIAL EXHIBITION, SEPTEMBER 11TH TO 19TH.

The Provincial Exhibition which opens at Halifax on September 11th will have many features that have never been before at a Provincial Fair. The foot races on the scale now contemplated are something new. The rivalry between the athletic men of the colleges should draw a big crowd of the devotees of the running track. The Mount Allison team have intimated their intention of coming to Halifax several days before the Exhibition opens in order that they may train and get into the best of condition.

There are races for other amateurs besides the college men and a good prize is offered for boys under 16 years.

The Horse Races are always interesting and sixteen of them for purses amounting to \$6,800, the biggest yet.

The greatest feature of the Exhibition will be the Aeroplane flights by Walsh on a Curtiss Aeroplane. Never before has an aeroplane been in Nova Scotia or indeed in the Maritime Provinces and this will be the first opportunity the people have had of seeing this form of aerial navigation. Far different from the old balloon method now practically a thing of the past.

The Vaudeville will consist of seven acts headed by Cedora of the Golden Globe of Death. A night performance in front of the Grand Stand will be completed with a magnificent and unexpected display of fireworks.

NAVAL QUESTION TO BE LEFT OUT.

OTTAWA, Sept. 5.—Those who attend the big Borden banquet to be held at the Chateau Laurier next Wednesday night in expectation of being somewhat enlightened on the naval policy of the Government will be disappointed. THE HUDSON BAY ROUTE.

(Canadian Press.) TORONTO, Ont., Sept. 5.—The Monetary Times this week discusses the feasibility of the Hudson Bay route and maintains the opinion that it is entirely impracticable.

Would it not be better for the Dominion Government to concentrate its forces upon the development of the necessity for an immediate and further development of the ports of Montreal, St. John, Halifax, Vancouver, and other existing ports.
