THE CABLE SERVICE.

It is gratifying to find that the sister Maritime Provinces, as represented at the annual meeting of the Maritime Board of Trade last week, are in full accord with Prince Edward Island in demanding a better telegraphic service between this Island and the mainland.

Now resolutions are an excellent means of airing grievances and affording opportunities for orations at public gatherings. As a remedy for the grievance they are about as valuable as the doctor's written prescription in a case of illness.

It is up to the Prince Edward Islands Boards of Trade to follow this resolution up. Probably the provincial government will carry the case through without any urging on the part of the Boards of Trade, but it is the business of the latter bodies, representing as they do the interests of the whole province, to see the matter to a finish.

The opinion was expressed by the Maritime Board that "a second new cable is necessary." This is evident. To go on repairing the old cable or even to replace it by a new one, will be to go on inviting interruption and loss.

It is earnestly hoped that a thorough understanding will be arrived at at once as to what is being done, what is contemplated as a remedy and how soon the remedy will be applied.

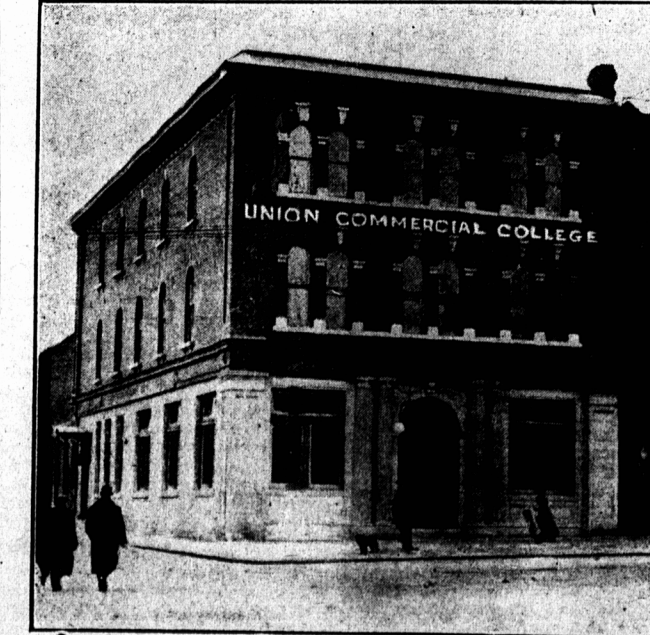

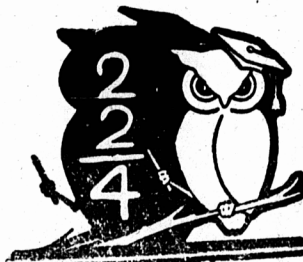

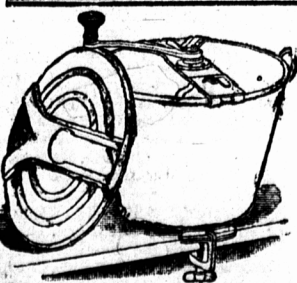
