Under the gas act the district of St. John includes the whole of New Brunswick, that of Halifax, the whole of Nova Scotia, and that of Charlottetown the whole of P. E. I.

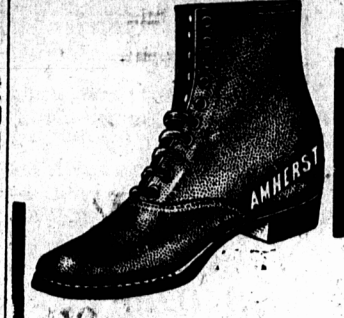
