MARKET REVIEW

In a review of general conditions, prevailing in Canada, the monthly Commercial Letter of the Canadian Bank of Commerce states that "a further moderate improvement in Canadian business came during the past month, again owing largely to seasonal influences, of which some were more than usually favorable."

crop a better start than in the average year although it is now entering the most critical period and requires satisfactory growing weather. An interesting reference is made to the recent increase in Canada's share of wheat exports. It is stated that during the first three weeks in May shipments of wheat from Canada, "accounted for about 50 percent of those from the four major exporting countries, as compared with 38 percent in April and 73 percent in March."

The letter deals further with satisfactory increases in the number of cars carrying revenue-producing freight loaded on the railways this year. There has been a reduction of only about 10 percent over last year with the smallest movement of grains and forest products accounting for most of the declines. For the week ended May 17, the number of grain cars exceeded that of the corresponding week of the previous year for the first time since last August. Merchandise in less than carlots and miscellaneous commodities, it is stated, "have moved in fair volume

the number of cars being only about 4 percent less than during the active winter and spring of 1929." May loadings were well up as compared with those of April.

NEWSPRINT

From reports received from nearly all the Canadian newsprint companies it is certain that when the official figures are issued offering the month of May, production will show a pleasing increase over that of April. As has been pointed out before, an increase for May far from being unusual, is the ordinary experience. It there were fears among the newsprint manufacturers this year that the ordinary course might not develop, and that demand might keep pretty much the same as for the month of April. It follows, therefore that the ratio of production for May should exceed that of April, which according to the capacity payments of the mills themselves would have shown in April probably not more than 70 percent. It is understood, however, that even according to the lower ratings of the newsprint mills, themselves, the ratio of output to installed capacity in May will have exceeded 70 percent.

This is taken by the leaders of the industry to be quite encouraging and to indicate that the feeling that business in general is slowly picking up is well founded. For newsprint production is probably one of the most reliable evidence of expanding or contracting business.

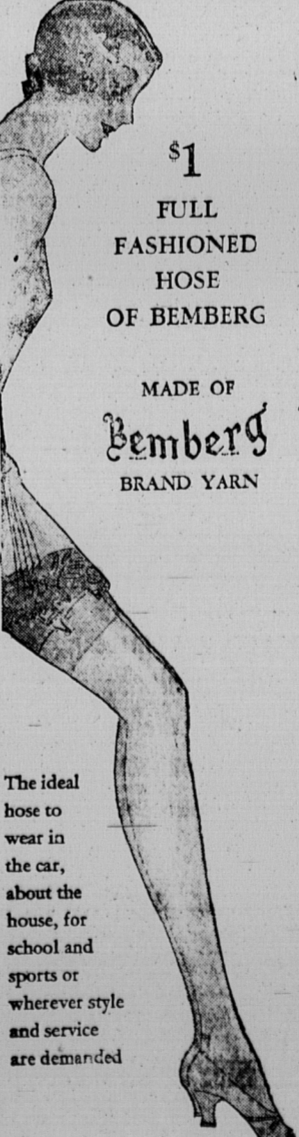
