## Twenty I. C. R. Men Retired

Thirteen Moncton Employees Take Annuity Many Applications. New Act Benefits Workers at Moncton, St. John, P. E. I. and Other Points.

OTTAWA, Sept. 12.—Twenty employees of the Intercolonial and the Prince Edward Railways have been retired from service and given the benefit of the annuity allowance under the provisions of the act passed at the last session of parliament. These are the first retirees under the act which went into force last spring. A total deal of time has been required for the organization of the board, a part of which had to be elected by the employees of the government railroads. It is probable that from the present, for some time numerous retirees will be announced, as there have been a good many applications for the benefit of the act from old employees of the road. The board will deal with them as fast as possible.

In the first batch of retirements, there are thirteen Moncton men:—David White, car inspector; William Steeth, moulder; Enoch Price, laborer; John Fogarty, machinist; James E. Seyre, foreman machinist; Thomas Hogan, watchman; William Glover, engine cleaner; Marcelin L. Blane, laborer; Samuel Thibodeau, carpenter; Damas Perry, machinist; Samuel Hamilton, carpenter; Douglas Nicol, carpenter; John E. Goodrup, blacksmith. There are three St. John men: Alexander Fraser, blacksmith; Thomas W. Prince, engine driver; and E. L. Perkins, storekeeper. Others retired are Archibald McKelvie, car inspector; Summerside Patrick Ashe, section foreman; Waverly, N. S.; James Christal, section foreman; Harcourt, and Mrs. Eliza Frupp, car cleaner, Halifax.


