for which Canada made large sacrifices in blood and treasure. Not that that was unimportant; it was more important. Britain expended a billion dollars to retain her hold upon South Africa, and yet had all been lost except Cape Colony and Natal.

A war with the United States is almost unthinkable now, and so little is the danger feared that we have not a fortification of a gun along the thousands of miles of international boundary. On the seaward side, if Britain were once to lose the supremacy of the ocean, our ports and our commerce would alike be exposed to capture or destruction by any one of a half dozen formidable naval powers which may yet become hostile.

So far good. But there are divided opinions as to what ought to be done. One opinion is that we ought to have naval ship yards, and build and man ships of our own. That seems plausible enough, but it will take time. At best only the smaller class of war vessels could be built and equipped in Canada for years to come.

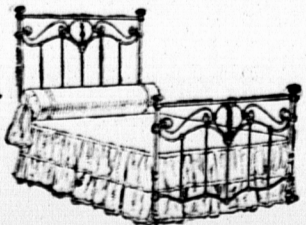

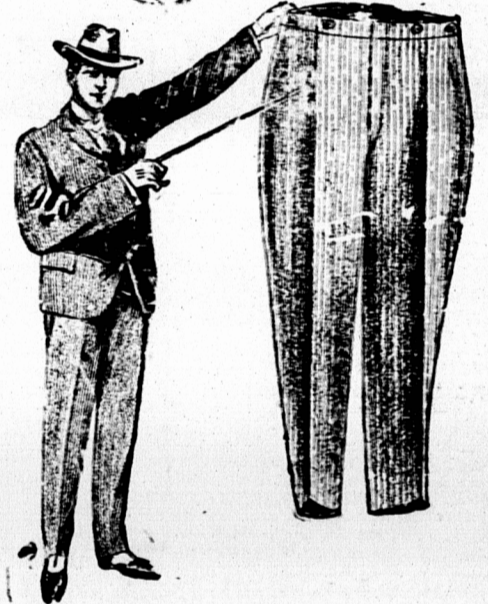
