Markets At A Glance

CONTROL OF MOLES
(Science Service News)
No easy or complete method for controlling moles has yet been found. Each year, especially in late spring and summer, the general destructiveness of these animals on farms, golf courses, and in gardens gives rise to many enquiries regarding control measures, says B. Glendinning, Officer in charge, Dominion Entomological Laboratory, Agassiz, B.C.

Unfortunately spring or summer is about the worst time to effect control owing to the extensive wandering habits of moles at these seasons. Extensive migration takes place then, and the shallow surface runways made by the animals are frequently not used a second time. This makes trapping under these conditions unsatisfactory. Studies carried out at the Agassiz Laboratory of the Division of Entomology, Dominion Department of Agriculture, have shown that during autumn, winter and early spring the Scheffer mole, the common species in British Columbia, lives chiefly in grass land, each mole constructing a network of feeding runways and remaining within a circumscribed area. This habit facilitates the placement of traps. Poison baits, gasses, explosives and patent mole exterminators were found to be ineffective at Agassiz.

A circular entitled, "Mole Control in British Columbia," may be obtained from the Division of Entomology, Department of Agriculture, Ottawa, or from the Entomological Laboratory, Agassiz, B.C. This publication gives details on habits and control methods.

It should be borne in mind by residents on the Prairies that no true moles occur there. The animals spoken of as "moles" are really pocket gophers, ground squirrels or prairie dogs. They are rodents, with very different structures and habits to true moles, which along with shrews belong to another group of animals with entirely different food habits. Consequently recommendations given in bulletins dealing with true moles are useless against the "prairie moles" or gophers. Gassing and poison baits are amongst the best methods for controlling the latter.

Gives Figures On Gold Reserve

OTTAWA, Dec. 8—Canada's reserve of gold and United States dollars which started the year at \$1,244,900,000 had been reduced to \$480,200,000 by Nov. 30, according to a return tabled in the Commons today by Finance Minister Abbott.

Of this amount \$467,100,000 was held by the Foreign Exchange Control Board of the Bank of Canada and \$13,100,000 by the Dominion Government.

Imperial Oil Drills Well In Gaspe Area

TORONTO, Dec. 8—(CP)—Imperial Oil Ltd. announced today that it has acquired an interest in acreage held by Continental Petroleum, Ltd., in the Gaspe Peninsula of Quebec. The announcement added:

"Along with Gaspe Oil Ventures Ltd., these companies are participating in drilling a joint well on the Bald Mountain anticline. The well now is at a depth of 1,500 feet.

The Bald Mountain anticline location is about 30 miles west of the town of Gaspe on the peninsula's east coast.
