The controversy resolves about that old classic, "Who's loony now?" The pan-Germans insist that the pacifist element has worried itself into insanity, while the Tageblatt suggests that an alienist should make a study of the pan-Germans.

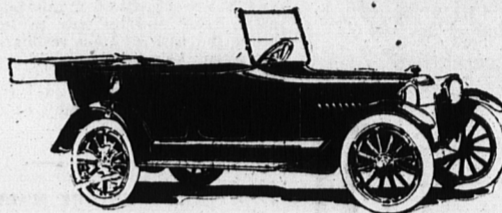
