Stock Markets At A Glance

WINNIPEG, March 21 (CP) - Rye prices ranged higher in quiet trading on the Winnipeg Grain Exchange today, futures posting quotations 1 1/8-1 1/2 cent higher. Still awaiting the expected government order restricting feed grain usage, futures brokers generally left today's transactions to slow in-and-out trade.

NEW YORK, March 21 (AP) - The stock market with scattered exceptions, continued to move into recovery ground today, favorites adding fractions to 2 or more points and a few issues climbing as much as 7.

The Associated Press 60-stock composite was up 3 of a point at 70 3/4.

Canadian stocks were strong with Canadian Pacific up 5-6. Dime up 4-8 and Hiram Walker up 1-2. Distillers Seagram gained as much as 1 1/4. Lake Shore on the curb was unchanged.

SOME OF THE DAY'S (CP) - Base Metals firmed 4/8 and the western oils added 1/8. Gold stocks took an index of 34 on the Toronto Stock Exchange today. Steep Rock had a recovery of 25 cents to close at \$ 30 on sizeable volume. Other stronger base metals were Nickel, Falconbridge, Normetal, Wainwright and Bend Oreille. Sherritt lost 7 cents on the news of the Indian Lake gold lodes moved ahead on heavy volume. Indian Lake led with a gain of 28 cents to 72. Beault's gained 10 to 90 cents on trade of 161,000 shares and Colomac was up 10 cents to 85.
