SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON
THIRD QUARTER.
WORDS AND WORKS OF JESUS AS RECORDED IN THE GOSPELS.
LESSON XII.—DECEMBER 23.
JESUS ASCENDS INTO HEAVEN.
Luke 21. 36-43 Memorize verses 46-48.
GOLDEN TEXT.
While he blessed them, he was parted from them, and carried up into heaven.—Luke 24. 51.

Time.—Sunday, April 9, and May 18, A. D. 30.

EXPLANATION.

36. "As they thus spake."—The reference is to the disciples who had gathered together somewhere in Jerusalem and had received from different members of their company the report of the resurrection of Jesus. "Fears be unto you"—The sad events of the preceding days had wrought to the hearts and minds of the disciples a deep sorrow. The hatred of the Jews, together with the loss of their Master, added fear to sorrow. Hence they gathered in secret places and behind closed doors. The Master's presence ultimately brought peace and confidence, but at first when he appeared they were too disturbed and frightened to believe the testimony of their senses.

37. "Supposed that they had seen a spirit."—One of the strongest proofs of the fact of the resurrection of Christ is this straightforward report of the skepticism of the disciples at his appearance. The very simplicity of the narrative vouches for its historicity.

38. "Behold my hands and my feet."—The nail prints in hands and feet formed a means of identification which could not be doubted. "Flesh and bones as ye see me have"—The body with which Jesus rose from the dead was the same body which had been buried. Its decay having been miraculously prevented. The fact that Jesus in his life was without sin left his body also without the stain of sin, and hence prepared for glorification.

41. "Ye believe not."—A persistent yet honest doubt which Jesus always respected. "Any more?"

42. "An honeycomb."—Honey in the comb.

44. "These are the words which I spake unto you"—From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day (Matt. 16. 21).

"All things . . . which were written concerning me."—Referring to all the prophecies of the Old Testament concerning Christ.

45. "Opened he their understanding."—Compare Application.

50. "As far as to Bethany."—Probably near Bethany on the Mount of Olives. (Comp. Acts 1. 12).

51. "He was parted from them, and carried up into heaven."—"And a cloud received him out of their sight." Acts 1. 9).

53. "And were continually in the tem

ple, praising and blessing God."—"And these all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication" (Acts 1. 14). The word "Amen" is omitted by the Revision.

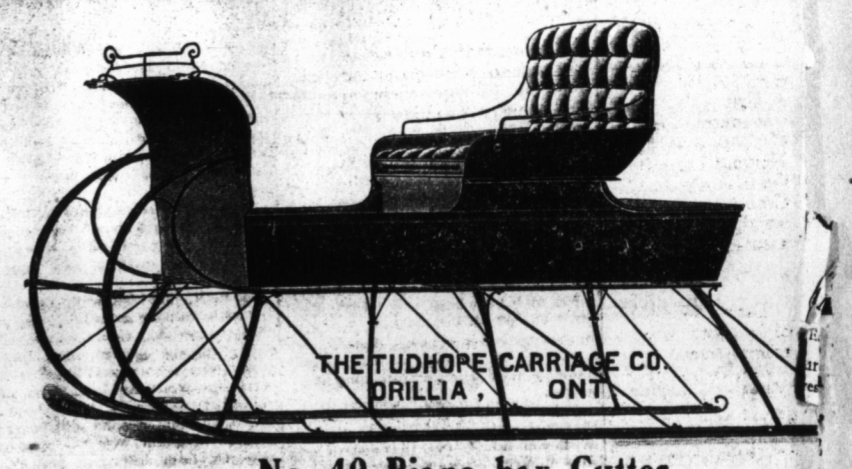
