Cook's Corner

Broiled Kidney Kabobs
8 lamb or 5 veal kidneys
1-4 cup French dressing
2 egg whites
METHOD: Split the kidneys straight across horizontally, so that they will retain their distinctive shape. Remove the white membrane and tubes and soak in salted water for about 30 minutes. Drain and dry. Then place in a French dressing that has been highly seasoned and allow to stand in it for a few minutes. Now arrange the kidneys on skewers alternately with unpeeled tomato quarters.

Kidney Loaf

1 pound beef kidneys
1 cup milk
8 slices bread
1-4 cup bacon drippings
2 eggs, slightly beaten
1 small bunch green onions, chopped
1-2 teaspoon sage
METHOD: Wash the beef kidneys in cold water and then grind. Put the milk over the bread slices. Combine the ground kidneys and the moistened bread with the rest of the ingredients and mix thoroughly. Pack firmly into a loaf pan and bake in a moderate oven (350 deg. F.) for 1-1/2 hours. This is nice served with tomato sauce.
