Contract Bridge

HELP NEEDED

In today's deal the declarer, aided and abetted by weak defense and by the fortunate position of minor trumps, fulfilled a game contract that had no real chance.

West dealer. Neither side vulnerable.

North's raise to three spades, even though delayed, was extremely optimistic. Certainly, his partner had everything he could have, in view of his bidding up to that point and yet a four-spade contract is not to be engaged in lightly—always assuming, of course, that the defense is reasonably good.

As it happened, however, the defense faltered badly. West opened the club six; East put up the ace, and instead of shifting to trumps, to prevent dummy from ruffing clubs and hearts, led back the

heart mine. Declarer promptly ducked, and now East, no doubt feeling that everything was under beautiful control, laid down the diamond king to reassure his partner about that suit. When West played the deuce of diamonds East went back to hearts. The play now won the trick with the ace and promptly led to the club king and ruffed a club in dummy.

Now a diamond was ruffed with the spade deuce and the closed hands' last club was ruffed with dummy's last trump. It now became necessary for the declarer to return to his own hand in order to draw trumps. There was nothing left in dummy but diamonds and if South had ruffed with the spade-honor, he would have lost a trick to East's eight of trumps. Recognizing, however, that there was only one hope—to ruff low without being over-ruffed—South trumped the diamond with the spade six, and when East could not top that bid and made.

It West had shifted to a trump at the second trick, South's position would have been hopeless.
