Isaiah v: 11-23.
Golden Text—Wine is a mocker strong drink is raging. Prov. xiii. Verse 11—How many men do you know in this community whose moral portrait is drawn in this verse; that is, those who are habitual drunkards?

Are there still those whose chief ambition is to get drunk?

What are the chief "woes" of the drunkard (1) To himself (2) To his family (3) To the community?

Verse 12—Is it a fact that drinking men still like string music, and, is so how do you account for it?

Is it either possible or probable that a man given to drink, can also "regard the work of the Lord"?

Verse 13—Upon which kind of knowledge does the prosperity of an individual, or of a people, most depend, moral and spiritual, or scientific and commercial?
