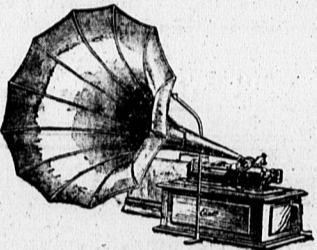

Mrs. William McVean, North River, was struck with paralysis the day of her husband's funeral, and lies in a critical condition.

Business was brisk in Montague yesterday and two schooners, loaded with produce, the Mayflower and Happy-go-lucky, cleared for Sydney.

Sunday night at 12 p. m. she took outward a large cargo for St John's, Nfld, including eighteen hundred bags of oats, one hundred bags potatoes, twenty-five bbls. of carrots and parsnips, fifty sheep and other sundries.

The funeral of the late Robt. McDearmid of Montague took place to Lower Montague Cemetery on Friday afternoon and was largely attended. His two sisters Bella and Maggie, arrived home in time, from Boston, for the funeral.

The following are the Souris market prices:—Pork per lb, 8 to 8 1/2 cts; oats per bus, 38 to 40c; potatoes per bus 14 to 16c; beef per lb, 5 to 7 cts; hides per lb 10c; calves, 40 to 50 cents; hay per ton \$10 to \$12 and straw per ton \$5 to \$6.

What might have been a serious accident occurred in Souris West on Friday last. The well known truckman, Robert Blackett, was backing his horse to the edge of a steep bank, to empty his cart of its load, when having backed too far, the cart went over the bank. Mr Blackett holding to the bridle of the horse was also pulled over. The horse was very badly bruised. Mr Blackett was resting easily when latest report was received of his condition.

The tide of the 30th was the highest ever known in the East. Little Harbor Beach was covered with many feet of water and the breakers rolled in on Andrew Morrison's field, something never before seen. A fish house, some dories and many lobster traps were destroyed there. The south end of Red Point lobster factory is wrecked. South Basin Bridge was covered with a foot of water, and the road round the Basin was covered to Joseph Ching's fence. At North River two fish houses were carried away with all their contents.—Priest Pond bridge was also covered with water.
