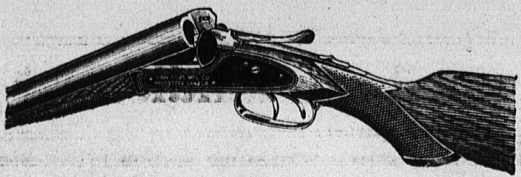

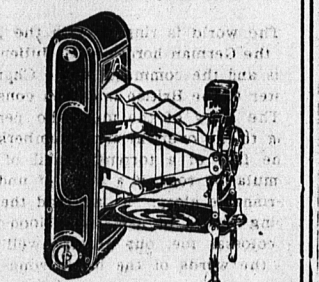

"Just a few lines to tell you I am well and living which I expect you are all anxious to hear. Well dear father the Canadians have been having a hot time of it for over a week. They got mixed up with the Germans and badly annihilated but we saved the situation for four days until we got reinforcements up, and I came through without a scratch. I do believe it was one of the worst battles ever in history. Von Hindenburg's Army made an awful attempt to get through to Calais. We saved Ypres and I think the Canadians did well as their was 20 to 1 of odds against them."
