ELASTIC GIRL MYSTERY

Doctors are to examine a Birmingham girl of fifteen who is stated to have elastic limbs which she can stretch at will like indiarubber.

STRAWBERRY FUDGE
Make the fudge in the usual way using your favorite recipe, but omit cocoa or any other flavoring. While the candy is cooking place one-half cup of whole preserved strawberries in a strainer to let the juice drain off. Just before it is time to remove the fudge from the stove roll the strawberries in confectioner's sugar until they have acquired a thick coating of the sugar. Then add them slowly to the fudge, beat until creamy, after allowing the

fudge to cool, and then pour into pan. Cut in squares.
WALNUT MOCHA CAKE
One-half cup butter, 1 cup sugar, 1 1/2 cup coffee infusion, 1 1/2 cups flour, 2 1/2 teaspoons baking powder, whites of 3 eggs, 1/2 cup walnut meats broken in small pieces. Cream butter and sugar, add coffee, then flour and baking powder sifted together, whites of eggs, beaten until stiff, and nuts. Cover with plain coffee frosting. Bake in a loaf cake about 3/4 of an hour.

STUFFING FOR POULTRY
Fourteen common crackers put through meat grinder (or about 2 cups ground dried bread crumbs), 3 or 4 onions ground, about 1/4 pound of fat salt pork, 1/2 tablespoon salt, 1 tablespoon poultry seasoning. Pour on boiling water and mix. For a large chicken double the recipe.
