**Red Cross Clinic at Murray River**

One of the outstanding events in the busy life of Murray Harbor and one around which a great deal of interest centered, was the holding of a tonsil and adenoid clinic at that place on Thursday last for the children of Murray Harbor and surrounding districts, organized by Miss Vickerson of the Red Cross society, assisted by the Women's Institute of the district who were indefatigable in their efforts to assist the nurses and Drs. Brehaut and Grant. The manse was quickly converted into a hospital, the parlor being used as the operating room while cots for the children were put up elsewhere the cots and bedding in many cases being supplied by the parents and ladies of the district.

Drs. Brehaut and Grant operated on seventeen children, removing tonsils and adenoids most successfully. The Women's Institute had appointed a committee, Mrs. (Dr.) Brehaut, Mrs. Fred Brehaut, and Mrs. Buell, to assist in organizing the clinic and they did their work nobly, being ably assisted by Mr. Buell and the teacher Miss Clements while the members of the Junior Red Cross willingly ran errands, moved cots, and were always there when called on.

Everything that was possible was done to make the day as easy as possible for the little patients and their mothers, the latter being taken out to dinner at the different homes, while others had to remain overnight with their patients. Everyone was interested and the success of the clinic will be felt later on in the robust health of the rising generation who in turn will keep up the good work started in their childhood by the Red Cross. After the nurses had completed a strenuous day's work they drove to their several homes.
