Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS. ANY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 5 and 20, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one quarter section of 160 acres more or less. Entry must be made personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated. Entries must be made personally at the local and office for the district in which the land is situated. The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith under one of the following plans: (1) A homestead residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years. (2) If the father or mother, if the father is deceased, or the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the homestead, as to residence may be satisfied by any person residing with the father or mother. (3) If the settler has his permanent residence upon farming land owned by him in the vicinity of his homestead, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land. (4) Six months' notice in writing should be given to the commissioner of Dominion Lands, Ottawa, of intention to apply for patent. W. W. GORY, Deputy Minister of the Interior, N. B. ORCHID PRESENT FOR ROOSEVELT SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 27.—President Roosevelt is to be the recipient of one of the finest collections of orchids ever sent to this country, the gift of Manuel de Yriarte, a wealthy Filipino planter. Seven thousand varieties are included in the shipment brought to this country by the army transport Thomas, which arrived Saturday. When Miss Alice Roosevelt was in Manila she was invited to visit the conservatory of the planter. The President's daughter spoke of her father's admiration for the orchid and the gift which has been sent to this country is the result.

FRENCH SOLDIERS LEARN TRADES PARIS, Aug. 27.—The minister of war issued a circular to the commanders of all army corps directing attention to be paid to the technical education of young Frenchmen while they are serving their time in the army. He points out that young men when they join the army are already fairly well skilled in their trades, and what is required is that their interest in their trades should be maintained and stimulated. Three classes, he thinks, should be formed—commercial, industrial and agricultural—in each of which a special form of instruction should be provided. Lectures are to be given and visits paid to manufactories and commercial houses. Commanders are ordered to draw up programs in accordance with these instructions and submit them by October 1.

EGYPTIANS LIKE LORD CROMER LONDON, Aug. 25.—"It is not possible for me to explain properly to you how much the Egyptians like Lord Cromer." In these words an Egyptian gentleman, who holds a prominent official position in his native country, who is at present in London, expressed himself. "He is a father to us and we would all fight to the death for him. To the small farmer especially and there are a large number of small holders in Egypt," Lord Cromer is a very little while ago he introduced a revised system of land taxation, by which the owner of poor land is relieved of some part of the burden of taxation. Formerly, the Pachas and the big owners of land paid practically no land tax, and then property was called oskori, or free. They, of course, possessed the most fertile land. "Now they are made to pay 164 piastres (34s.) an acre land tax, while the owner of poorer land pays less in proportion to the value of his land for agriculture, down to a minimum of 20s per acre. That is justice. It is marvellous to the small Egyptian farmer to feel that if he has a grievance he can go to Lord Cromer and speak face to face with him, and get attention and justice. Lord Cromer is always travelling about among us. You do not hear of it over here. He is too quiet a man for that. But we know, and we love him for it."

BRITAIN LOSES FIVE MILLION PORTSMOUTH, August, 27.—The following statement in regard to the ship, of the loss of which the officers were dismissed from the navy, was issued by the British admiralty. "As it was found that no attempt to float the Montagu could be made during these spring tides owing to the delays caused by recent heavy weather, it has been decided that no further steps will be taken to save the hull of that vessel." The crews are dismantling the Montagu of all salvage gear and the four remaining large guns. Considerable activity is likely to continue for some days. The Montagu will afterwards be sold by auction. Nearly five million dollars have been lost to the nation by the wreck of the Montagu. The battleship was one of the largest and most modern in the navy, having been launched in 1901 and completed in 1903 at a cost of \$4,807,355. The salvage operations have extended over two months, and the cost must have run into hundreds of thousands of dollars.


