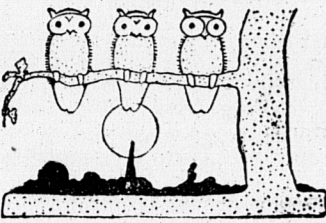

### FARMERS OF WEST MAY HIT BACK

@CALGARY, Alta., March 2—That the farmers of the Western Provinces are seriously considering the advisability of making an effort to have the three Provinces of Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta separated from the Canadian Federation and form an independent colony is the purpose of a story appearing in the Calgary News Telegram. It is the allegation of the Calgary paper that the matter was taken and discussed, at a meeting of the United Farmers, held Thursday here. The meeting was not public, but farmers who attended, admitted that such a possibility was talked of. They, however, take the matter smilingly and not seriously. It is said that the action would be considered too revolutionary. "It is not improbable that the farmers will take up policies for their own protection and organize a third party, party which would simply eliminate the Liberal and Conservative parties in the Prairie Provinces," says the Calgary paper.

### BAPTIST TEMPERANCE WORKER INDICTED

FORT WORTH, Tex., March 2—A few hours after Rev. F. Norris, pastor of the First Baptist Church had been indicted on the charge of perjury, his home was burned down last night. It came as a mysterious sequel to an equally mysterious chain of events in which the saloon fighting Baptist minister has figured. The most startling development came last night when accused of perjury Norris was charged with having written letters to himself in which he was threatened with death if he did not leave town, Norris first attracted attention here by campaigns for enforcement of prohibition laws. Then Norris declared an attempt had been made to assassinate him. This was followed by the destruction of the First Baptist Church by fire. Norris said a second attempt had been made on his life after this and he travelled with a body guard. Then he exhibited warning letters which last night the Grand Jury declared Norris wrote himself.

### MUTILATED HEAD ON FROZEN PRAIRIE

PRINCE ALBERT, Sask., March 2—The badly mutilated head of a human being was discovered on the shore of South Saskatchewan River at a point twenty five miles from this city. ### EUROPEAN POWERS DESIRE OF PEACE

PARIS, March 2—It is stated upon excellent authority that the European Powers have agreed to intervene in the Italian-Turkish war with the object of obtaining peace. The initiative came from some of the Powers, who succeeded in getting Germany and Austria of the Triple Entente to join them in collective representations to the Porte, with the object, it is believed, of inducing the Turkish Government to accept Italy's decree of the annexation of Tripoli.

### \$100,000 GIFT FOR BISHOP DOANE

ALBANY, N. Y., March 2—Women in all parts of the country and some in lands across the sea will contribute to the success of the celebration of the eightieth birthday anniversary today of Bishop William Crosswell Doane, first Episcopal Bishop of the Diocese of Albany.

In no part of his work has the Bishop taken a greater interest than in the building up of St. Agnes' School for girls, for many years one of the most widely known schools of the kind in this country. Women who have attended this institution can be found in nearly every State, and an endowment fund of \$100,000 for the school is raised and presented it to the Bishop this morning.

### RUSSIAN SERVICE TO CANADA BEGINS.

HALIFAX, March 3—The first trip of the latest line to open up a regular service to Canada was made today, when the steamer Lithuania, of the Russian East Asiatic Steamship Company, arrived at Libau. The steamer had 976 passengers, of whom 341 were for Canada and landed here, proceeding by I. C. S. special train, and 365 going on with the Lithuania for New York.

The company is strongly backed by the Russian government, and it is proposed to make fortnightly trips the year round to Halifax.

The immigration officials here say her passengers are equal in quality to any that ever landed here and as far as money supplies are concerned they pronounce them better off than any heretofore handled surpassing in this respect even over the immigrants from the United Kingdom. The passage from Libau was made in eleven days. The next steamer of the line will be the Kursk, built in the company at Glasgow in 1910 and having a gross tonnage of 7,858. The Lithuania's tonnage is 4,248, and she was built at Belfast in 1884. She is commanded by Capt. Zerle. The most of her passengers are destined for Sudbury, Winnipeg and Cochrane, in Montreal.

THE BRITISH NAVY TO HAVE A MOTOR-DRIVEN WARSHIP LONDON, March 2—The report is revived that the plans of the government have been matured for the construction of a big motor driven warship for the British navy. It is about that the British admiralty is about to try to construct such a vessel in record time in the successful manner as was done in the case of the first Dreadnought, and thereby have the advantage of several months' experience before the German ship which is said to be on the stocks is launched.
