LONDON.—Baron Davenport, Food Controller, yesterday ordered all cheese imported from Canada, Australia and the United States requisitioned and henceforth will control all dealings in it. Cheese will be put on the market at a price enabling the retailers to sell it at sixteen pence per pound.

THE JAPS SAVED 2,800 OUT 3,000

(Canadian Press Despatch.) TOKIO.—An announcement issued by the admiralty today says that the British troopship "Transylvania," which was torpedoed in the Mediterranean on May 4, was being escorted by Japanese destroyers. The destroyers engaged the submarine. According to the statement the Japanese rescued 2,800 out of 3,000 troops on the Transylvania, winning the praises of Japan's allies by their bravery.

BARBARY OF THE HUN AT MONS

(Canadian Press Despatch.) HAVRE.—The Belgian authorities today made public a copy of an order served by the Germans on the city of Mons, as showing bad faith by the Germans in their announcement that deportations had been stopped, at the request of Pope Benedict. The order, which is dated April 15, requires Mons to furnish six hundred young men at a German cavalry barracks before noon of the following day, equipped with clothing, shoes and provisions.

Polish Army in France is Underway

(Canadian Press Despatch.) GENÈVE.—The Polish state council has decided to suspend its official functions as a protest against the hostile policies of the German authorities toward Polish national aspirations, according to a communication from Warsaw received by the Polish Agency at Lausanne. Two Polish deputies have been arrested, says the despatch, and the Germans seem by their severity to be driving the Poles into the arms of Russia.

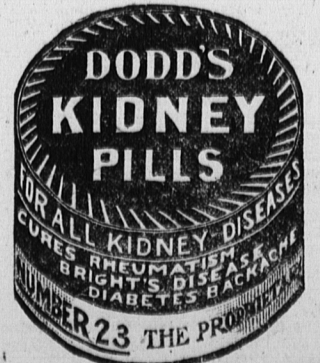
