Hints for the Motorist

COMMON CARBURETOR AILMENTS

A Speck of Dirt—In The Wrong Place—Will Stall Any Car Missing and failure of power is often caused by the clogging of the strainer, that is generally provided where the fuel enters the carburetor, and to avoid trouble, this should be cleaned rather frequently.

Water in the buretor causes, at first, occasional missed explosions, which become more frequent until sometimes the engine stops. Draining the carburetor bowl, through the check or plugged opening in its bottom and the drawing off of water accumulations in the vacuum-tank and main tank are the remedies.

Solid impurities, lodged in the gasoline spraying nozzle and other small passages, of the carburetor cause misfiring, faulty mixture quality and lack of power, particularly at open throttle. Opening the gasoline needle valve and racing the engine will sometimes remove such obstructions.

Removing the needle-valve, and flushing the float-chamber heavily and allowing gasoline to wash freely through the spraying nozzle will frequently wash out the foreign matter, but often the carburetor must be taken apart and the passages cleared by means of fine stiff wire or blowing through them.

One should know the construction of one's carburetor and just what channels there are that can become clogged. Generally these have their outer ends closed by screw plugs which, when removed, permit a wire to be passed through. Every carburetor ought to be cleaned out periodically and this kind of trouble forestalled.

The moving parts of carburetors wear out in time. Pins that are moved by connection to the throttle, get out of adjustment when lost motion has accumulated.

Check or plugged opening in its bottom and the drawing off of water accumulations in the vacuum-tank and main tank are the remedies.

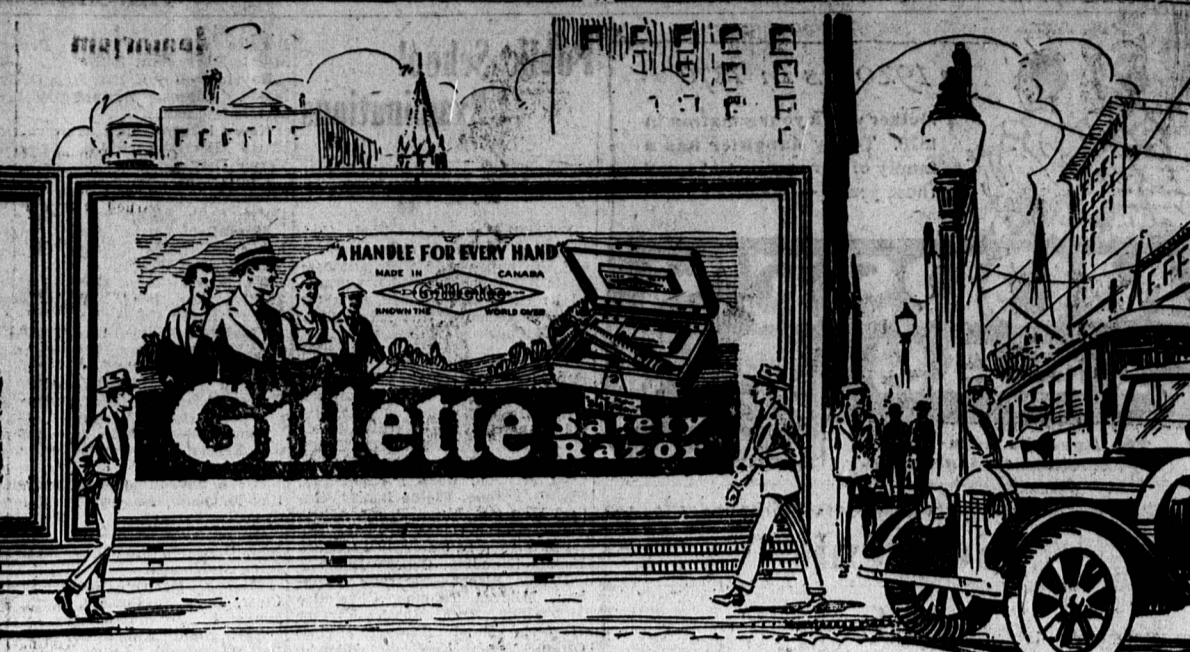
