DR. TROTTER CAN NOT RECONSIDER

WOLFVILLE, April 11.—At yesterday's meeting of the government of Acadia College, Dr. Trotter adhered to his decision to resign the presidency. He said that his health absolutely forbade his continuing the work the responsibility of which he felt to be particularly heavy.

The governors asked him to accept a full year's salary without work or responsibility, and at the end of it they would then consider the matter of his resignation. He felt he could not, resume the work. The most he would accept would be five months' salary at the end of the year, which is Jan. 1.

A committee, of which Rev. Dr. Saunders is chairman and B.H. Eaton is secretary, was appointed to nominate a successor and another committee with Dr. Cohoon as chairman was appointed to take in charge the matter of a suitable testimonial.

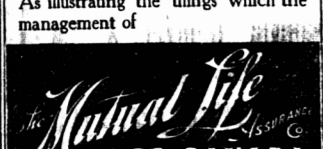
