Flying Officer's Club here. The
club is an automobile owned
by A. S. Bishop, River de Chute,
and a wrecked plane, nearby
houses threatened before fire-
men subdued the flames. Loss was
estimated at several thousand
dollars. Cause of the fire is un-
known.
