THE COOK'S CORNER

CHILI SAUCE

Chop 16 ripe tomatoes, 3 or 4 red peppers, 2 onions. Add 2 tablespoons salt, 2 tablespoons ginger, 1 tablespoon cinnamon, 1 tablespoon cloves, 1 tablespoon muscadine, 1 tablespoon nutmeg, 1/2 cup sugar and boil for about 2 1/2 hours until mixture is right consistency, being careful it does not scorch.

TOMATO SOY

Peel and slice 4 lbs. ripe tomatoes and 6 large onions. Spread 1 cup salt between layers of vegetables. Let soak over night. Drain, then slice 3 large red peppers thin, add to mixture with 1 qt. vinegar and 1 teaspoon whole cloves and 1 teaspoon allspice (in muslin bag). Cook slowly 2 or 3 hours. When nearly done add 2 lbs. brown sugar, 1/2 lb. mustard seed, remove from stove and add 1/2 oz. celery seed. Bottle hot.
