THE MARKETS (Canadian Press)

MONTREAL, Que., Jan. 4. - The foreign demand for Canadian grain on the Montreal market today was of a very limited character and little business of importance was done.

There was some demand from New York exporters for Manitoba spring wheat here and sales of some fair sized lots were made at C. I. F. prices Buffalo, and they also took a few loads of barley on the same basis.

Some No. 3 barley was sold to local exporters at three cents per bushel under the Winnipeg May option track Port William.

The local and country demand for coarse grains was quiet and the volume of business was small.

Prices for spring and winter wheat grades of flour were well maintained under a quiet demand.

The millfeed market was fairly active and the undertone was firm.

Standard grades of rolled oats for which the demand was quiet.

A feature of the egg trade was the somewhat unsettled feeling that developed in the market for strictly fresh eggs owing to the more liberal supplies coming toward from Canadian centres and the fact that the arrivals from the United States have been larger than was generally expected with the result that the offerings were ample to fill all requirements.

On the other hand the tone of the market for storage eggs was firm. The receipts were 1,970 cases.

A stronger feeling prevailed in the market for potatoes and prices scored an advance of five cents per bag which was attributed to the increased demand. Car lots of Prince Edward Island Green Mount potatoes were quoted at \$1.75 to \$1.80 per bag of 90 pounds.

New Brunswick green mountains at \$1.60 and Quebec white stock at \$1.45 to \$1.60 per bag of 90 pounds extra. Considerable business was again transacted in butter and prices ruled firm. No. 1 pasteurized was quoted at 41 1/2 cents to 42 cents per pound.

The receipts were 61 packages. Only a small volume of business was done in cases of prices were steady. Western grades were quoted at 18 1/2 to 19 cents per pound. The receipts were 241 boxes.

OTTAWA, Ont., Jan. 4. - (Eggs) Three cars of states storage are reported to have arrived in Toronto costing about 40c delivered.

Toronto - Fresh much weaker local receipts little heavier but weakness largely due imports from states. Dealers report buying extra 55, firsts 50, seconds 30 to 32, delivered. Wholesale extras 65, firsts 55 to 60, seconds 38, jobbing extras 65, firsts 55, seconds 38, storage fairly steady.

Montreal - Few local ungraded eggs arriving. Quotations delivered extras 55 to 63, firsts 50 to 55, pullets 45 to 60, seconds 40. Wholesale fresh extras 68 to 70, firsts 64 to 65, pullets 54, storage extras 45 to 47, firsts 44 to 44, seconds 38 to 40.

Edmonton - Egg market firm, storage stocks all cleaned up. Local receipts very light. Country shippers received extras 50, firsts 45, seconds 40, turkey receipts light, shippers receiving 32 credited.
