RUSSIA'S TARIFF.

NEW YORK, Feb. 18.—Regarding the effects of the American discriminating tariff against sugar imported from Russia and the Russian retaliatory excess duty of 30 per cent on American iron manufactures Charles Strong Guthrie president of the American Steel Hoop Company, a corporation with a capital of \$33,000,000, said:

"The Tariff Russia imposes upon steel and iron imports is already the highest in the world. If this additional duty is imposed upon our products it does not seem possible that our trade in steel and iron with the Russians can continue."

TO BUILD STEEL SHIPS.

NEW YORK, Feb. 18.—The Press says: Another of Andrew Carnegie's dreams is nearing realization. That is the establishment here of the greatest shipbuilding yards in the world. Right alongside the largest iron and steel plant ever projected Staten Island is the place named for these industries, and some recent purchases of several hundred acres of shore land are said to have been made with this in view.

CANADIAN RIFLE CLUBS.

OTTAWA, February 17.—Hon. F. W. Borden, minister of militia, proposes to encourage rifle practice and shooting in Canada by prompting the formation of rifle clubs throughout the Dominion, the government to provide arms and grant the use, where possible, of government ranges. The scheme will be based on provisions to be announced in the next issue of the Militia Gazette and similar to those passed by the Victoria (Australia) legislature. Militia officers will probably be in command of clubs. Every member will be required to engage for three years and will be liable for active service in the militia for that period. A first class reserve will thus be formed for the active militia.
