 DOMINION DAY.

The thirty-seventh anniversary of the Dominion naturally recalls the progress made since the union. In that time our population has nearly doubled; the area of Canada has increased six-fold, to 3,745,000 square miles. Ours is a vast possession, 3,500 miles from east to west, 1400 miles from north to south. Halifax is nearer to London than to Vancouver, and Victoria is half way between London and Hong Kong. One third of the entire British Empire is ruled from Ottawa.

Our railway mileage has increased over six fold, from 3,000 to 19,000 miles, with a proportionate increase in passengers and freight carried. In 1868 there were 18 million letters mailed in Canada, and 235 millions in 1903, a thirteen fold increase. Our railways have cost over a billion dollars. Our 72 miles of canals represent an expenditure of over \$80,000,000 over a million dollars per mile. Canada has 36,000 miles of land and cable telegraph wires and 94,000 miles of telephone wires. Canada's volume of trade reached \$467,000,000 in 1903 and is rapidly growing. It equals \$85 per head of our population, or about three times the rate per head in the United States. The national revenue is more than five times what it was at confederation. Canada produced last year 63 millions worth of minerals, 19 millions worth of which was gold, and the Dominion ranks fourth among gold-producing countries. Our wheat crop last year reached 100 million bushels. We sold Great Britain 100 millions worth of farm products of all kinds, including 25 millions worth of cheese, out of 31 millions worth of cheese imported there.

Canada has 19,386 public schools with 1,026,032 pupils, and spends 12 millions annually on her public schools. Canada has

17 universities, and 83 colleges attended by 15,000 students. Her six leading religious bodies have 16,300 ministers and priests. Her people are at peace among themselves, prosperous, contented and full of hope for the future. Canada is "a land of settled government, a land of just and fair renown and a land where girl by friends or foe a man may speak the thing he will." So may it ever be.
