LABOR'S ANNIVERSARY.

Many are the sayings of the wise in ancient and modern books enrolled extolling honest labor, and in no country are these more grateful to the ear than in Canada. In no country is a larger proportion of the adult population so constantly employed in work of brain or hand, each alike necessary to the other. "In all labor there is profit," and, "he that gathereth by labor shall increase," are among the sayings of Solomon. Proverbs of other nations tell that "labor conquers all things;" that labor is a pleasure in itself; that "with labor is honor;" and that "to work is to worship."

While thus the wise men of all ages recognized the utility and dignity of labor, it is only in modern times that this recognition has become general. In the early centuries and down to modern dates the laborer was a slave, a serf, or the servant of some feudal lord. Christianity taught the doctrine of universal brotherhood and as this great principle spread abroad in the world the working man became a citizen, a voter, with a share in the government of most civilized countries. More recently with the multiplication of industries the workers have become organized in societies and unions, by means of which they command increasing influence and recognition, social and political.

From the nature of things our population being largely agricultural and our Province having few "roofed industries," labor organizations have not been formed here on any extended scale, not being so necessary as elsewhere, but throughout Canada labor commands as much equitable recognition as in any other country. There is a Department of Labor at Ottawa, which is doing a large and beneficent work in disseminating information, fixing a scale of fair wages on all public contracts and assisting in the settlement of disputes between employers and employees.

The annual Labor Day which is observed throughout the United States and Canada is one of the fruits of the official recognition obtained by the army of workers. We congratulate the local Unions on the success attained in the sports of yesterday which were a special feature of the celebration. Our best athletes are found among the workers, and in a field day of athletic events they never fail to give a good account of themselves. Regrettably the weather was unfavorable, thus diminishing the attendance and otherwise detracting from the interest in these healthful pastimes.

The annual Labor Day which is observed throughout the United States and Canada is one of the fruits of the official recognition obtained by the army of workers. We congratulate the local Unions on the success attained in the sports of yesterday which were a special feature of the celebration. Our best athletes are found among the workers, and in a field day of athletic events they never fail to give a good account of themselves. Regrettably the weather was unfavorable, thus diminishing the attendance and otherwise detracting from the interest in these healthful pastimes.

Rev. A. E. during the Exhibition week in the vicinity of the fruit exhibit, and make such other local experiments, as may be deemed necessary. The fruit crop will not, we regret to learn, be an extra one this autumn, and it is important that the most be made of it, so growers will do well to take advantage of this service in packing offered by the Federal department.

Thus speaks the Hamilton Spectator:—"Instead of dividing Ontario into two Provinces to please some ambitious Scot people, the number of Provinces in the Dominion should be decreased. New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island should be merged into one Province. We have too many Parliaments in this country, too much government entirely."

BELL'S AIRSHIP IS SUCCESSFUL

New York, Sept. 2.—The Herald today has the following from Paris:—"The aeronautical world of Paris was considerably staggered yesterday by The Herald's cable in which it was stated that Captain Anglemire has risen two hundred feet above the earth with an aeroplane invented by Prof. Bell, relying for its motive force upon an electric current transmitted to the machine from a station on the ground."

M. Santos Dumont was discovered by a Herald correspondent working at his new aeroplane at Neuilly. He said he had read the article and confessed to being astonished. "If the report be true," he said, "it may be considered a remarkable manifestation of transmission of power through the air. The remarkable feature about Prof. Bell's experiment is undoubtedly that his machine could derive sufficient power from a dynamo on the ground without wires or other connection. But if the flying machine is to have any practical value it is obvious that it must have its own power of elevation within itself; otherwise its scope is of a most limited nature."
