Cards Extend Winning Streak To 11 Games

NEW YORK, July 27—(AP)—Adding to the longest winning streak of the year in the major leagues, St. Louis Cardinals won their 10th and 11th games in a row today at St. Louis, by taking a doubleheader from Philadelphia Phillies.

Murray Dickson, yielding only five hits, captured the opener of the twin bill 6-2 and Howard Kristianson triumphed over his favorite victim in the nightcap, 5-3.

The clean sweep increased the Cardinal's National League lead over Brooklyn Dodgers to 9½ games and, at the same time, dumped the slipping Phillies into seventh place.

At Cincinnati, sparked by catcher Phil Masi's three hits and a walk in four times at bat, Boston's

Braves trounced Cincinnati 6-2 in the first of a five-game series.

Bucky Walters retired in the eighth in favor of Clyde Shoun and a three-run outburst to record his 11th defeat against five victories.

Jim Tobin scattered seven hits in gaining victory No. 9. In Pittsburgh, the Pirates whacked out three home runs to beat New York Giants 8-5 as they started a new drive for second place.

The roundtrippers by Maurice Van Robays with one on in the first, Tom O'Brien with two on in the fourth and Bob Elliott with none on in the fourth, accounted for six runs as the Pirates came from behind to erase an early 4-2 giant lead.

Babe Ruth Back Today In Yankee Stadium

NEW YORK, July 27—(AP)—The big guy is coming home tomorrow: home to the vast concrete house he built with his two powerful arms and the rotation of that huge, barrel-like torso.

The one and only Babe Ruth returns to the Yankee Stadium—the house that Ruth built—as manager-for-a-day of a team made up of members of the Yankee and Cleveland Indian squads, known as the Yankees, which meets the cloudbusters of the North Carolina Navy pre-flight school in an exhibition game as part of a Red Cross benefit double header.

The Yanks and Indians play their regularly scheduled game in the other half of the bill.

It won't be the Ruth of old. He won't roll up to the plate with that mincing stride to send a baseball in a tremendous arc into the right field bleachers. He won't—that is, unless he personally elects himself to the role of pinch hitter—and late reports indicate he will confine his duties strictly to managing.

Coming Yeo Theatres Suspense Is Expensive—But It Pays Dividends!

There's no priority on suspense, but the price is high—and if the picture happens to be an air epic, the sky's the limit.

Director William A. Wellman, who believes that the public's screen thrills must compete with the daily newspaper headlines for appeal, practiced what he preaches on 20th Century-Fox's "Thunder Birds," soldiers of the Air. The film stars Gene Tierney, features Preston Foster and John Sutton, and opens at the Yeo Theatre.

Noted for a lavish hand with devices calculated to keep an audience on edge, Wellman discovered that in "Thunder Birds," soldiers of the Air, he had outstripped even his successes in "Public Enemy" and "Wings."

One reason for the high stunt costs of the picture was the 103 daring plane maneuvers he planned for the exciting action scenes. The cost is not figured in dollars alone, for it is the meticulous thoroughness of the director which results in the thrills on the screen.

This was demonstrated while on location at airports near Phoenix, Arizona. Four days of shooting were spent on a ranch where Wellman experimented on how close a stunt flyer could come to a water tank in which Gene Tierney was bathing. The scene required 27 takes. Accurate measurement was impossible but the diving plane one time cleared the tank by less than eight feet.

It required 19 parachute jumps in a dust storm before Wellman got the effect he wanted for one of the most thrilling sequences in Technicolor epic.

The parachute jumps were expensive and dangerous—and in addition spotting planes had to be hired to find dust storms in the Arizona desert, then moving the camera and crew to the scene.

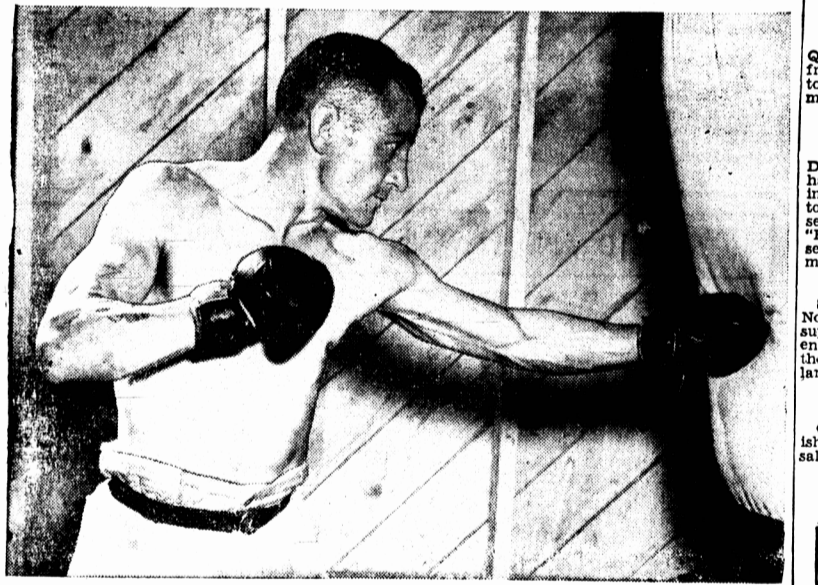
Fitzsimmons just rejoined the Dodgers after an absence of several days, during which he was conferring with William D. Cox, president of the Phillies, in New York.

Former Ring Champ Becomes R.C.A.F. Gunner



LAC Al Foreman (above) of Montreal, who retired nine years ago as undefeated lightweight champion of the British Empire, has reentered the ring in the R.C.A.F. with the same determination and courage which gained him more than 300 victories in his fist career. Never knocked out in the ring, Foreman hopes to knock down enemy planes with the same cool effectiveness which crashed more than 200 boxing adversaries to the canvas.

The stocky little lightweight, holder of the world's record for one round knockouts and conqueror of three world's champions in over-weight contests, has trained for his chance to fight Fritz just as keenly as he would for a title bout. He reduced 20 pounds to make sure he was at the peak of his physical condition for his aircrew examination. He passed all tests with honors. "We have high regard for Foreman's qualifications as an air gunner," said the chairman of the aircrew selection board at LeCharon.

Until recently, Foreman, who is within four months of his 39th birthday, was considered too old for air crew. Recruiting officers said they were sorry, but they couldn't overlook the rule which set the maximum age for air gunners at 33.

So Foreman, a crack news photographer with the Montreal Standard and Colonial Airways, enlisted in the photographic section of the

R.C.A.F. slugging away long hours at Rockcliffe as a "darkroom Joe." "The recruiting officer hinted me that if they ever raised the age limit, they'd let me reenter as the air gunner. I was the happiest man in the air force when the age limit was raised to 39, for I knew my eyes and reflexes were good as ever. Once I trimmed down my weight, I was confident I'd have no trouble passing the physical requirements," he said.

When the age limit was raised, Foreman set out to get in shape. Bundled in heavy sweaters, he did his roadwork along the paths of Rockcliffe, punched the bag, and sparred with R.C.A.F. pals until ringer went around the camp that he intended to "make a comeback."

So he did, but it wasn't in the ring. It was in the gun turret of an R.C.A.F. bomber in the bigger game of war.

When he went before the medical board, he had reduced his weight from 153 pounds to 133, just six pounds heavier than his best fighting weight.

"I'd like to be a gunner in the tail of a Lancaster," said Foreman. "It's a good responsible position where I'd see plenty of action, and besides, I'd have two more guns than the other lads."

He suggested that many Canadian athletes who thought they were "washed up" because of their age would make good gunners. "Boxers would make better-than-

average air gunners, for they have been trained to split-second timing, they're cool under fire, and their reactions are good. The air force doctors passed my reflexes as perfect, for example, at 38, I find I'm fit as any youngster. I'm sure there a lot of athletes in Canada who'd give anything for a crack at Jerry, but are under the erroneous impression that they are too old for air crew."

A member of the C.N.R. Pistol Club at Montreal, Foreman is a fine rifle and pistol shot, which he thinks should help him to master his machine guns.
