COMING FOR CONFERENCE

LONDON, May 9.—Altho no official confirmation can be obtained here, it is reported that the forthcoming visit of the British postmaster general to Canada is connected with the subject of a state-owned cable to link up with the Pacific cable. He will also attend the subsidiary conference in the Dominion at which other questions of Imperial interest will be discussed, the most important being the problem of defence in its later development. Ministers from other Dominions will also attend the conference.
