MARIE CORELLI PREDICTS END OF THE WORLD.

LONDON, October 14.—Marie Corelli has written another book and the matter is as sulphurous as the title, which is "The Devil's Motor." It was issued recently and will certainly create a sensation. Primarily the book describes the adventures of the devil at the wheel of a hat appears to be a combination aeroplane and automobile and through it all runs the apocalyptic vision of the end of the world, according to Corelli.

As described by the author of "Wormwood" and "The Romance of Two Worlds," the devil's motor rushes forth, while in its train go all the forces that are destined to ruin mankind. When the time of this diabolic ride occurs the world is one vast network of cities and factories. All the altitudes of the earth have gone. "There will be no virtue," says Marie Corelli in a prose which just escapes being blank verse. "Honor shall be as a rag on a fool's back. Gold will be the pulse of life." "The people of the world," exclaims the exulting devil, "will fight for gold, steal it, pile it up, hug it, sleep with it, die with it, sell their souls and bodies for it. God has sworn to give unto me all those who reject him, and the hour for gathering up the gift has come!" Corelli then pictures the morphia fiends, the maniac anarchists, the courtesans and plotters against peace to whom the world shall shortly be surrendered. When the full agony has been piled up the novelist pictures the devil's motor as plunging over a precipice into a bottomless abyss of the Unseen and the Unknown. Then the sun rises slowly, setting the seal of God on the closed history of the world.
