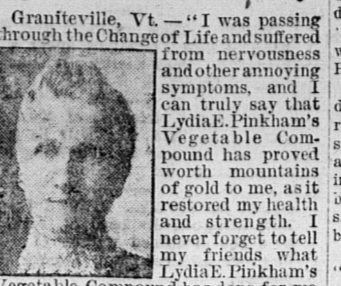

COUNTESS MURDERED WHILE AT TELEPHONE

PARIS, April 7.—The Countess de Flerieu was murdered under extraordinary circumstances at her house, near Algiers, at a place called Constantine Ferry.

The murder had aroused great excitement, owing to the personality of the victim who was a leader of Algiers society, and to the strange conditions under which the crime was discovered. These recall the play "Heard at the Telephone," which is well known both in London and in Paris.

Count de Flerieu left home a few days ago for France and the countess remained alone in her house at Constantine Ferry with the servants. At about 8.30 in the night a friend of hers in Algiers was called to the telephone by the countess, who told her that she had only rung her up for a chat, because she felt so lonely.

"It's horribly lonely here," she said, "I am all alone in this great place, with a maid, who is at the other end of the house and cannot even hear me when I call. 'Where are the other servants?' asked her friend. 'They have been called—' said the countess' voice, and then communication was cut off.
