SPICE CAKE WITHOUT EGGS

Have one pound of flour; six ounces butter, four ounces orange peel; one ounce ground cloves; one ounce ground cinnamon; one ounce Jamaica pepper; half pound of sugar; half pound currants; one and a half teaspoon of bicarbonate of soda, sour milk.

NOURISHING TYPES OF SOUP

Serve soup—rich and hot, at this time of year. It is nourishing and healthful. Some soups are almost whole meals in themselves. Those containing potatoes, milk, and dried Lima beans are both nourishing and economical.

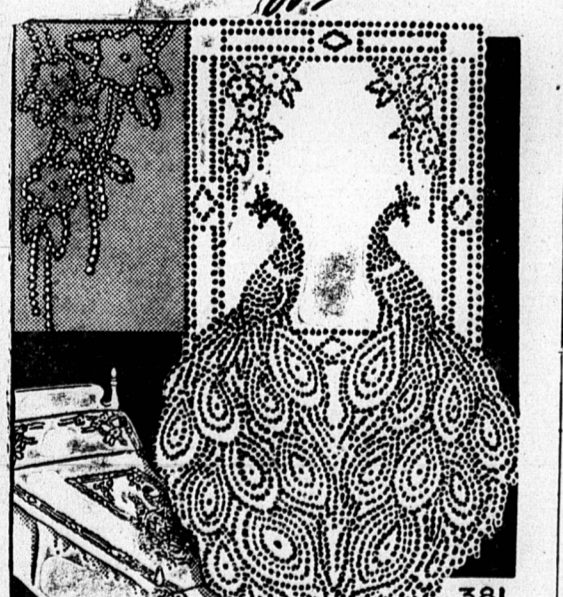
