opening of the House, their theme. If that busy paper had only allowed them to drift on their crooked course they would have succeeded in robbing in many an unwary taxpayer of moneys which were not due, AND HAVE MULCTED THEM IN OVERCHARGES WHICH WERE ABSOLUTELY WITHOUT JUSTIFICATION, EITHER IN EQUITY OR LAW. Some of their methods were exposed by Hon. Mr. Arsenault, but these only indicate a few of the instances which came to light, but may be typical of hundreds of similar instances to be found all over the country, for many do not notice and others do not report. They get a tax bill, they think it is right, and without investigation, they pay. One man was assessed for 60 acres, \$500, taxed at one half of one per cent, \$1.50. The man didn't have 60 acres, if he had it would be worth \$2,000, and even at the \$500 valuation the correct rate should be \$2.50. In another instance a farm assessed at \$2,000 was taxed at the double rate, or one per cent, \$20.00 where by law he was only liable for half the amount or \$10.00.

It is because the Opposition and the Guardian are continually like faithful watch dogs on their tracks exposing these crooked methods and protecting the country from their unjust impositions that they are opening up their venom bags and letting loose their wrath, but in all their roamings in this wilderness of despair they will continue to find this popular public monitor upon their track, bringing them to the bar of public justice, regardless of their discomfiture or their puerile attacks. Another of their blunders is in those letters of apology sent out to cover their previous mistakes. If these were few they could be met by an ordinary typewritten letter, but their mistakes are so numerous that they have had to create a PRINTED FORM in order to supply enough to cover the whole ground. These mistakes must surely be vast in number to require so many forms, and the postage alone on these apologies for INCORRECT TAX NOTICES sent out, must in itself be a big charge upon the revenues of the province.

And as Hon. Mr. Arsenault said, why are all these mistakes being made? For while the Arsenault Government had only six clerks employed in the tax office, they have had, off and on, sixteen. It certainly could not have been for need of clerical help that all those blundering mistakes were made in "TAXATION" manipulations of the Government. If, as they deliberately and repeatedly charged against the Conservatives prior to the last election, the clerks were so numerous as to be "in each other's way," and "tumbling over each other," WHEN THERE WERE ONLY SIX, then with SIXTEEN at their disposal there were surely sufficient to send out tax notices without this multiplicity of mistakes. The statement of Hon. Mr. Lea, "by mistake tax notices were sent, copied from a list of those who had paid, instead of those who had not," is particularly disgraceful in its disclosures. Where would you get in connection with any business concern, such carelessness and such neglect as this, and admitted by the head of the Department?
