AGRICULTURAL FURLOUGH - With seeding operations about three weeks away, farmers are looking forward to the relief afforded by the agricultural furrough allowance this year. Those on active service are permitted six weeks leave for the purpose of aiding in the seeding operations on the farms of this province. This furrough is granted to troops in Military District No. 6, which includes the Island, in common with other parts of Canada. It is also understood that the trainees at Beach Grove who are "R" recruits will be able to get a certain amount of leave to assist in crop work. Only farmers or those having experience in farm work who are eligible for this time off. All leaves are to end June 15. Military pay and allowances are withdrawn during the period of agricultural furrough. There are certain limitations on the soldiers allowed to take advantage of the order.
