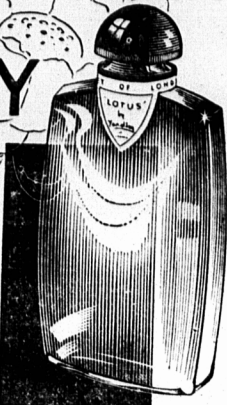

**THE COOK'S CORNER**  
**CRANBERRY CRISPCROSS PIE** (Serves Eight)  
One and three-quarter cups sugar, 3-4 cup water, 4 cups cranberries, 1-4 teaspoon quick tapioca, 1-4 teaspoon salt, 2 tablespoons butter, 1 recipe pie crust, 2 egg whites, 4 table-poons sugar.  
Boil sugar and water for 5 minutes. Fill pie with cranberries and boil without stirring until skins break (about 5 minutes). Cool. Add tapioca, salt and butter and let stand for 15 minutes. Line a 9-inch pie plate with about 1-2 of pastry, rolled 1-8 inch thick, allowing pastry to extend 1 inch beyond edge. Fold edge back to form standing rim. Fill with cranberry mixture. Moisten edge of pie with cold water and arrange lattice of pastry strips across top. Flute rim with fingers. Bake in a hot oven (450 degrees F.) 15 minutes, then decrease heat to moderate (350 degrees F.) and bake 25 minutes longer.

**REFRIGERATOR COOKIES**  
One cup minced cooked beef, two cups mashed potatoes, one egg, two spoons chili sauce, one egg, flour or egg and crumbs.  
Combine beef, hot seasoned mashed potato and chili sauce. Beat egg and work into the mass. Chill and shape in small cakes. Dip into seasoned flour or into crumbs, beaten egg and crumbs again. Fry in very hot fat, 300 degs. F., for two to four minutes. Garnish with parsley and serve with hot gravy.
