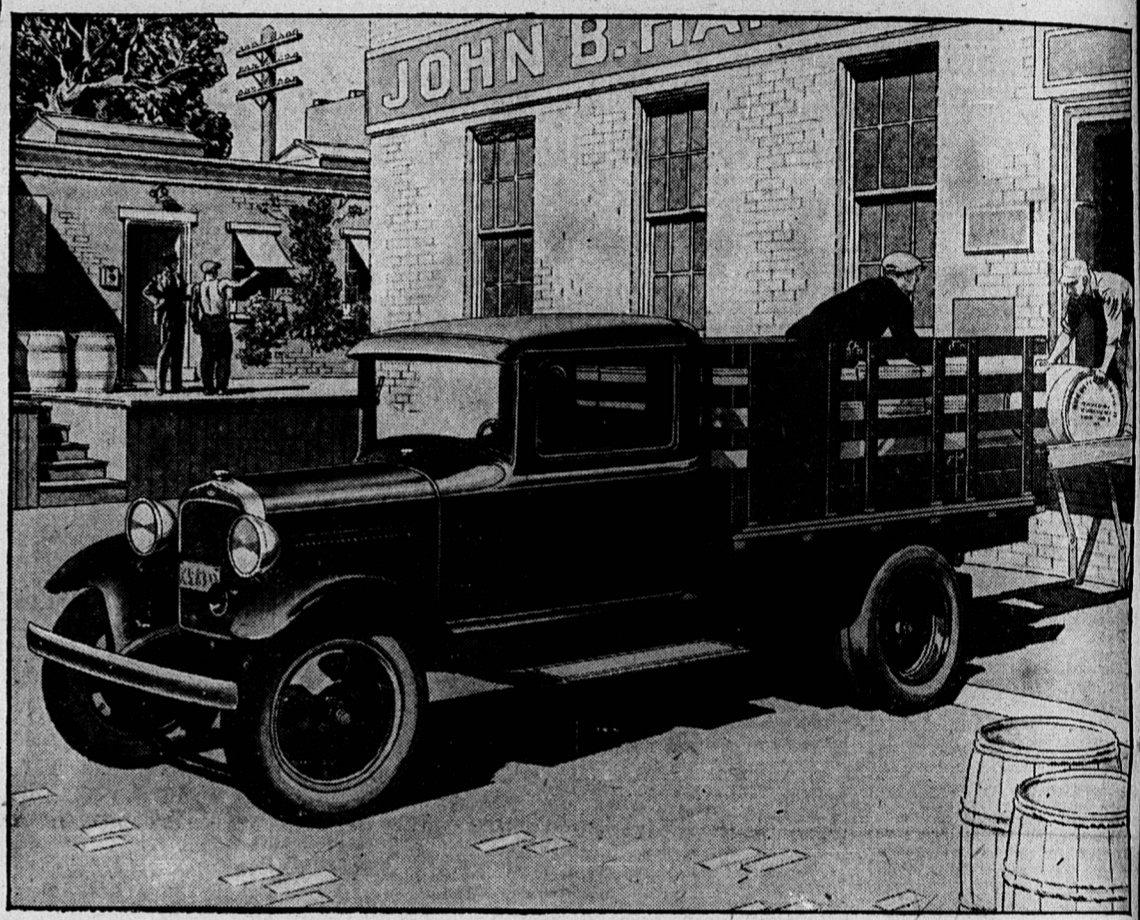

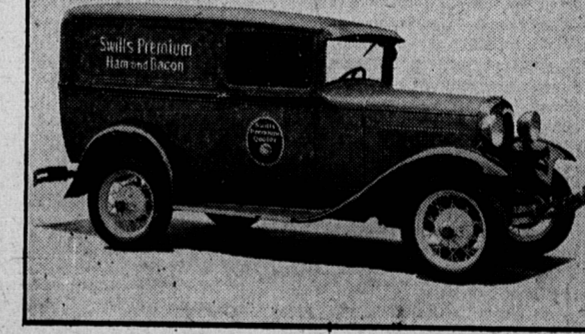


Stake body truck equipped with factory-built closed cab. Wheelbase, 131 1/2 inches
