SPEECH

MR. SPEAKER AND GENTLEMEN OF THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY:

I heartily welcome you on re-assembling for the performance of your Legislative duties, and I have much pleasure in congratulating you and the Province upon the general prosperity, which, through Divine Providence, has prevailed throughout the Island during the past year.

During the recess we were honored and pleased by a visit from His Excellency, our new Governor General, Earl Grey, who, during his short stay, had an opportunity of visiting the Macdonald Consolidated School at Hillsborough, which he formally opened, and with which he expressed himself highly gratified.

The idea of the consolidation of our schools seems to have taken a strong hold on the minds of many of our people, and I feel assured that if properly carried out it will be of great advantage to our system of education.

We were visited during recess by the Transportation Commission and also by the Tariff Commission, from both of which visits, especially the latter, we trust much benefit will accrue to this Province.

Will Absorb Kewatin Co. and Become the Largest Mill in the World.

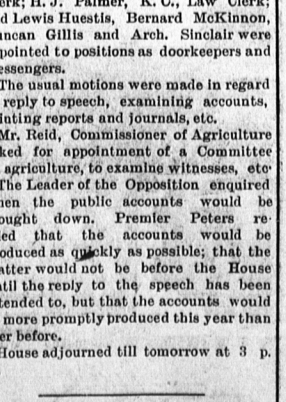

THE LAST TRIBUTE TO THE VENERABLE ARCHBISHOP

His Body Having Lain in State, Viewed By Thousands, Will be Interred Today--Rev. Dr. Morrison of Charlottetown Will Preach The Sermon--Religious Orders, Clergy, Governor, Judges, Members of Parliament, Legislature and Mayor of City Will Attend

HALIFAX, March 13.--(Special)--The body of Archbishop O'Brien is lying in state in St. Mary's Cathedral. Large numbers of people this morning took a last look at the familiar face of the dead Prelate.

The Cathedral will be closed after half past seven o'clock Mass in the morning and will be reopened at nine o'clock. Pontifical High Mass will commence at 10 o'clock sharp.

Seats are reserved at the head of the centre aisle for religious orders, choir, mourners, Chief Justice and Judges of the Supreme and County Courts, Lieut. Governor and staff, clergymen of other denominations, president and members of the Legislative Council, Speakers and Members of the House of Assembly, Mayor and corporation of the city of Halifax, Mayor and members of corporation town of Dartmouth, Warden and members of County Council.
