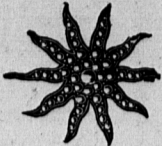

S. F. TarBush, of this city has received his appointment as organizer for the Canadian Order of Foresters, in the Maritime Provinces.
The Sacrament of the Lord's Supper will be dispensed in Caledonia on Sabbath, the 11th. inst. Preparatory services on Saturday at 11, a. m.
The pianoforte and song recital by Frank T. Watkis, Miss H. Bremner and E. Ritchie in St. James' Hall next Thursday cannot fail to please everyone.
Among the outward passengers from this city yesterday were Hollis Rowe to Tignish; Frank Stewart to Braddbane; J. B. Hegon to Montreal; Rev. Mr. Wade, Montague, to the United States.
Gordon Thompson, formerly of Springhill, but now of Florenceville, N. B., who is one of Canada's fastest skaters, is going to Boston for the winter. Thompson is one of the best all around skaters in Canada. He not only keeps up with the best in speed skating, but is one of the fastest backward skaters in eastern Canada and will compare with the greatest jumpers on skates in Canada. He expects to reach Boston about the middle of December.—Halifax Herald. (Thompson is well known here. He competed in the skating championship in the Arena last February.)
