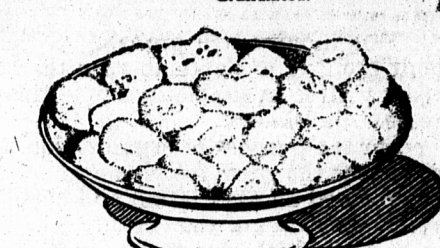

IN MEMORIAM

LATE CLIFFORD L. MULLINS. The lamented death of Clifford L. Mullins, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. D. Mullins, briefly recorded yesterday, was due to the rupture of a blood vessel in the brain, not to the blow received on the head, as he fell in a faint. He had been fishing with other boys at the time on Hillsborough Bridge and whether through over-exertion or otherwise he practically fell dead. He was rushed at once to the Prince Edward Island Hospital, where everything possible was done for him, but he never regained consciousness and passed away about half an hour after reaching the hospital. There are left to mourn, besides his parents, four sisters and two brothers, all at home. The tragic ending of a bright young life has evoked the heartfelt sympathy of
