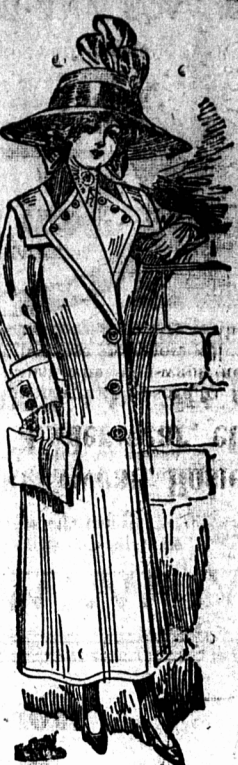
SUMMERSIDE AND ALBERTON

COLORADO FUEL & IRON

A month ago Colorado Fuel and Iron Common was selling around 30 and the Preferred shares around 106. Present prices show an advance of 12 points in the common and over 30 for the preferred. This rapid advance has given rise to many rumors, most of which are unjustified. It is only natural that more or less credence should be given to extraordinary rumors as it is controlled by George I. Gould and John D. Rockefeller. The Colorado Fuel and Iron Company, is not a large concern in respect to manufacturing capacity. The size of its capital stock and bonded indebtedness is apt to be misleading. The Colorado Fuel and Iron Company, has an outstanding bonded debt of \$42,521,000. It is capitalized for \$2,000,000 8 per cent Cumulative preferred stock and \$84,245,000 Common. During the past year, which has been a most favorable one in the iron trade, the Company has been able to earn a fair surplus available for dividends on the Common stock as well as the Preferred. The present high price for these shares is amply justified by the status of the Company.

DOCTOR'S RACE OVER

THE OCEAN. Long before the passengers on the Cunard liner Lusitania had landed on her last voyage, Professor A. Beckel, the radiium expert of Vienna, who had come over on that vessel from Liverpool, was speeding through New York in a motor car to the bedside of Mrs. Adolphus W. Green, wife of the president of the National Biscuit Company, who lives in Greenwich, Conn.

As soon as the professor cabled that he had left Vienna on his hurried journey to New York, arrangements were made to arrange his landing in this city, and these were carried out yesterday through the courtesy of the customs officials and the use of a chartered tug and a fast touring car.

When Mrs. Green's illness became alarming her physicians decided that it would be well to bring Dr. Beckel to this country to give the radiium treatment advised. He was instructed to come here as expeditiously as possible, and he succeeded in getting to Liverpool on September 7, a few hours before the Lusitania sailed.

If the fast Cunarder had been running at the high speed she had maintained a year ago, Dr. Beckel would have been at his patient's bedside before midnight on Thursday. It happened, however, that the Cunarder, through stress of weather and cranky engine, was able to make an average speed of only 23.27 knots, and did not get to the Lightship until 10.21 a. m. yesterday. Moreover, her wireless equipment did not work properly, and her whereabouts on the Atlantic was not known until shortly after midnight yesterday.

The tug Robert Palmer, cruising about Quarantine, went alongside the Lusitania as she came up the Narrows, and the moment she was cleared by the health officer Professor Beckel was taken aboard with a few pieces of hand baggage. Then heading for the Battery at top speed, she met the revenue cutter Calumet, which she signalled to come alongside. Presently an inspector from the surveyors' department and an acting deputy collector climbed aboard the Palmer and immediately examined the baggage of the Viennese radiium expert. Within an hour Professor Beckel landed at the Battery and was hurried in one of Mrs. Green's fast touring cars to the bedside of Mrs. Green, where Greenwich physicians and a specialist from Chicago were awaiting him.
