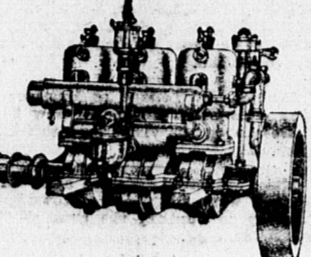
Synopsis of Canadian North-west Land Regulations.
