A CLEAN UP WEEK.—It has been suggested that Charlottetown like some other towns in the Maritime Provinces should have a "Clean-up Week." The idea is a good one. The method followed is for every citizen to clean up all the refuse lying about his premises and place it in barrels to be called for and taken away by a team sent by the city for that purpose. The daylight saving scheme is another live subject in the Maritime Provinces to-day. Halifax and St. John have adopted the idea of putting the clock back an hour in summer. Where does Charlottetown stand in regard to this idea?

COST OF BUILDING.—Charlottetown is not the only place where the cost of building has greatly increased within the past few years. The Pictou Advocate says: "A builder remarked the other day that the cost of building in Pictou had doubled during the past 15 years and in support of his statement gave us the following figures: Fifteen years ago flooring cost \$12 per thousand, it now costs \$25; scantling cost \$11 per thousand, it now costs \$20; laths cost \$1.50 per thousand, they now cost \$4.00; nails cost \$4.75, they now cost \$9.80; plastering cost 14 cents per square yard, it now costs 22 cents; labor cost \$1.50 per day, it now costs \$2.50. And thus the cost of living keeps a-soaring."
