Charlottetown 150 Years Ago

In the latter part of the 18th Century Prince Edward Island, then known as the Island of St. John, was surveyed by Captain Samuel Holland, the Surveyor-General of North America.

Charlottetown, which was named after Queen Charlotte, the wife of the then reigning sovereign of England, George the Third, is the Capital of Prince Edward Island, and has the distinction of being one of the oldest cities in Canada.

In 1769, when this Island became a self-governing Colony, Walter Patterson was appointed its first Governor, and the following year he landed in Charlottetown, and at once began to make arrangements for the Government of the Colony.

On the 24th of September, 1770, the Supreme Court held its first sitting; and on the 12th August, 1771 the first Grand Jury assembled in Charlottetown.

On the 7th of February, 1773, an Order in Council was passed providing that a house of representatives or general assembly of the inhabitants of this Island be forthwith called.

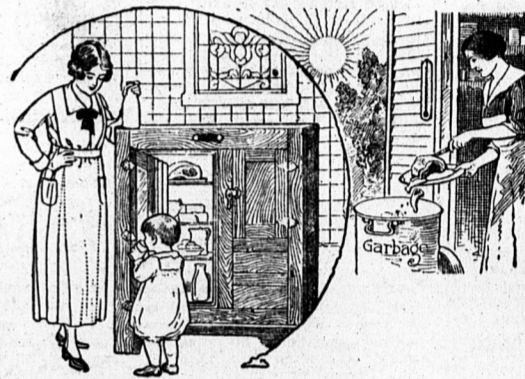
