BRANTFORD, Jan. 22.—James Taylor, a half-breed, charged with the murder of a 12-year-old child last September, will be hanged tomorrow. He pleaded insanity but has been pronounced sane and responsible for his actions although a moral degenerate.

REV. GEO. DUNCAN

A recent issue of the Edinburgh Evening Dispatch has the following item which will be of interest to the relatives and many friends here of Mr. Duncan. A cordial and unanimous call from St. Andrew's Church Montreal, has been received by the Rev. George G. D. Duncan, B.D., of St. Cuthbert's, Edinburgh, and it is understood that he has agreed to respond to the call. Mr. Duncan is a son of the late Rev. Dr. Thomas Duncan, latterly of Bridge-of-Weir. He was born in Canada, where his father carried out a long and successful ministry. He went early to Glasgow with a view to entering the Church, and in Glasgow University he attained a large degree of success.

SUCCESSFUL COLLEGE CAREER

In 1890 he graduated with honours in classics, and in the Theology course he won a couple of substantial bursaries, one of £100, and the other of £75. In his first year of Theology he took first prize in divinity, Church history, and in Hebrew exercises, and carried off the Rae-Wilson gold medal for original research work in Theology the subject being "Essenes." In the second year he took first prize in New Testament criticism, in Old Testament criticism, and for essays on Biblical criticism, and again carried off the Rae-Wilson medal. His last year was quite as fruitful in success as the previous years, for he carried off no less than three "firsts," in divinity, Biblical history, and Church history. He was first also in the graduates' list of the Divinity Hall by capturing the Fellowship in Theology, valued at £150, which led him to study at the University of Gena, Germany. On being licensed, he obtained an assistant ship in the Parish of Dron, Perthshire, and from there he went to Glendevon, the smallest parish in Scotland, in succession to Dr. Spiers, who went to Morningside Parish Church, Edinburgh. After two years' ministry at Glendevon, Mr. Duncan was called to Glencairn Parish Church, Duffrieshire, where there were two churches and four preaching stations, and where he succeeded Dr. Playfair, of St. Andrews. Early in 1907, Mr. Duncan was elected to the pastorate of Inveresk Parish Church, where, thanks to his earnest organizing, he greatly increased the strength of the congregation. He has published a treatise on The Essenes and on Modern Theories of the Resurrection.

CHARGE OF UNL-QUE OPPORTUNITY

St. Andrew's Church is now almost the only remaining charge of the original State Church of Scotland in Canada not incorporated in the Union of the Presbyterian Churches. The position is one of great influence and importance; but recent events have made the charge at present full of special possibilities and unique opportunity, and it is felt that the services of a man of proved experience and ability should be secured for the direction and development of a work of such great importance to Montreal and to the Church in Canada. The problems facing St. Andrew's are not financial. The congregation is a wealthy one, and the minimum stipend guaranteed is \$2,250, exclusive of fees which amount to a considerable income. It is interesting to note that almost exactly thirty years ago the Rev. Dr. Barclay left St. Cuthbert's for St. Paul's Montreal, where his distinguished ministry and influence have told powerfully upon the life of the whole Dominion.

Practical Fashion Hints



The peg-top is by far the most popular skirt model this season. It gives the modish wide waist and hip and does not make one look short and cut off as would at first be inferred. The lines are long and the folds are laid in gracefully about the waist. No. 7968 is a four-piece model with a slightly raised waist-line and a broad lapped seam down the center front and back. The thick, light weight wool materials, velours, duvetyns and velveteens lend themselves very well to this style of draping. With a skirt of this description it is well to make all the necessary changes, in fact completely finish the upper part of the skirt before turning the hem. I have found that much trouble is saved if after turning up and basting the hem it is pressed flat before stitching on the machine (if this is done) or hemming by hand. For a hand finished hem I find the short cut stitch practical and neat. This skirt will require for size 24 2/3 yards of 42 inch material. The pattern is cut in 5 sizes; 22 to 30.
