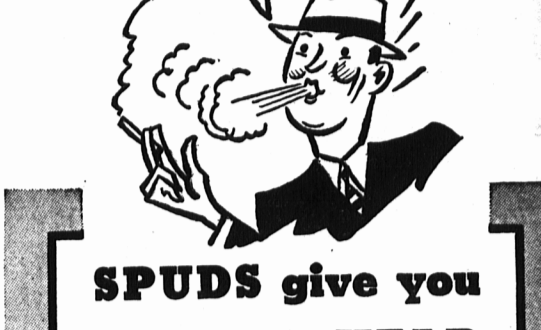
Bowling Results At Summerside
