PRES. FALLIERES' ACTION DENOUNCED

Crowds in Paris Cry "Down With Fallieres!"—Dispersed by Police—Demonstration Organized Against the Wave of Crime.

PARIS, Sept. 17.—The increasing indignation of the masses against the escape from the guillotine of Solleiland, who was sentenced to death for the atrocious murder of a girl 12 years old was commuted last week by President Fallieres to life imprisonment, was expressed today in a series of the most curious public manifestations that have occurred in France for a long time. The demonstration, despite the fact that several arrests were made, was almost entirely an orderly one. Many women participated in it. It was organized not so much against Solleiland as to express the voice of the populace against the wave of unspeakable crimes committed on little girls, which have lately increased to an alarming degree and which, it is feared the commutation of the sentence on Solleiland will only stimulate. Several thousand persons engaged in the demonstrations. The rage of the women of this district has been great since President Fallieres showed clemency to Solleiland. They assembled this afternoon with their husbands and other sympathizers, and the crowds were augmented by many curious persons. Their orderly cries for justice were quickly changed to cries of "Death to Solleiland!" and "Down with Fallieres!" as the procession, led by a woman who carried a little girl on her shoulders, with the purpose of indicating the object of the manifestation, moved toward the Place de la Republique. Soon the streets were choked by a vast mob, and the police reserves were called out to disperse it. The parade, however, assembled again, and several of the most violent demonstrators were arrested.

METHODISTS ARE TO COMBINE

Three English Bodies, With a Membership of 190,000 To Unite.

LONDON, Sept. 17.—Three Methodist bodies, the Methodist New Connexion, the United Methodist Free Churches, and the Bible Christian Methodist Church, will be formally merged into one organization this week under the name of the United Methodist Church. A conference of the three branches will open on Tuesday, and it is expected that 700 delegates from all parts of Great Britain, will be present. Each of the uniting bodies is an offshoot of the Wesleyan Methodist Church. The new combination will have a membership of 190,000. A feature of the conference will be the inauguration of a thanksgiving fund of \$50,000 for the purposes of the new church.

Synopsis of Canadian North-West HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS.

ANY even numbered section of Dominion Land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, excepting 8 and 28, not reserved may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, of any age over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of acres, more or less.

Entry must be made, personally at the local land office for the district in which the land is situated.

The homesteader is required to perform the conditions connected therewith: under one of the following plans:

1. At least six months residence upon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.
2. If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homesteader resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by such persons residing with the father or mother.
3. If the settler has his permanent residence upon a farm owned by him in the vicinity of his home farm, the requirements as to residence may be satisfied by residence upon the said land.

Six months' notice in writing should be given to the Commissioner of Dominion Land in Ottawa of intention to apply for patent.
