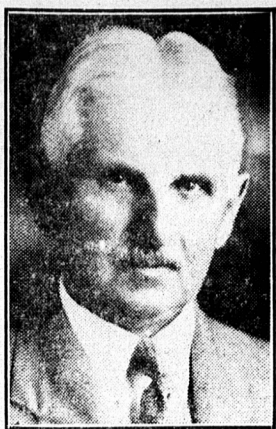

address to the shareholders pointed out that assets in all sections of the balance sheet showed a satisfactory increase for the year. The Company's guaranteed investment account comprised government bonds and similar high grade investments to the value of \$2,387,788.04.

837,392.30, which represents an increase of \$1,525,529.15 of this class of holdings in that account over the year preceding. The total funds held in guaranteed investment account represented an increase of \$379,850.76, the total being \$7,061,989.44.

As has been the practice in the past, the Company's assets were appraised at less than their actual market worth, yet showed a marked increase in value. The total assets under administration amounted to \$58,910,279.88 at the end of the year, representing an increase of \$1,534,663.44.
